

## German University Ranking for Global Health

### Summary:

Universities conduct important research and provide education in the field of global health. They are publicly financed independent institutions self-administering their social mission, therefore substantial aspects of prioritizing research and education is the responsibility of individual institutions.

Scorecards have been used by student networks, such as Universities Allied for Essential Medicines, to systematically assess and monitor contributions in global health in research and education of universities in the US and UK.

The aim of this project is to assess 36 public universities with medical schools in Germany to provide a ranking on global health related research and education.

The project is divided into three separate areas:

- The area “access” evaluates universities with regard to make health-related technologies based on research results global availability (socially responsible licensing) and asserts that that this is possible in low- and middle-incomes countries
  - The area “innovation” evaluates the university innovations in global health, including neglected tropical diseases and research and development for medicines for NTDs
- The range Empowerment rated the university education deals for students in Global Health
